

CPA/CPC Timeline

- **May 11, 2016** – City Council votes to adopt CPA (MGL Chapter 44B, Sections 3-7) and place the question on the November ballot
- **November 8, 2016** - Voters of Boston approved the CPA by a 74% to 26% margin
- **July 28, 2017** – Christine Poff appointed Director of the CPC
- **August 2, 2017** – City Council approved ordinance creating the CPC and establishing its responsibilities
- **August 11, 2017** – Mayor signs CPC ordinance
- **August 23, 2017** - City Council creates Special Committee on the Community Preservation Act to make recommendations to the full Council for the four At-Large members to the CPC
- **August 23, 2017** - City Council creates five-member temporary Working Group of Boston citizens to assist Council's Special Committee
- **October 4, 2017** – Names of the five members of the Working Group announced at City Council Meeting
- **November 9, 2017** – Deadline to submit applications for CPC
- **December 13, 2017** - Four At-Large members expected to be appointed to the CPC at City Council meeting
